

Bowie County for Oak Grove WSC - Pump Station Improvements



Hayter Engineering provided the engineering support for Bowie County and Oak Grove Water Supply Corporation to successfully apply to the Texas

Department of Agriculture, Community Development Block Grant program for a pump station improvements project to address service capacity and distribution deficiencies.

Improvements included a new 8,000 gallon hydro-pneumatic tank and foundation; below ground and above ground yard piping, ductile iron fittings, and gate valves; an 8' x 9' wood frame building; chlorination system improvements; LAS system; ground storage tank rehabilitation and ring modification; new air compressor, new hydro tank controls; new electrical system; new high service piping, roof vent, wall air conditioning unit, site fencing; and painting of all installed interior above grade piping.

This project was completed in August, 2012.
